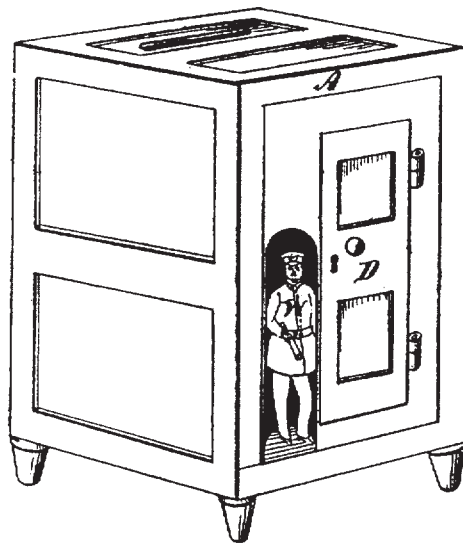

DESIGN FOR A TOY SAFE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 5,494, dated January 23, 1872.

Specification describing a Design for a Toy Safe, invented by ANTHONY M. SMITH, of Brooklyn city, in the county of Kings and State of New York.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of my "toy safe," which is provided with a door, D.

N is a niche. W is the figure of a watchman standing in the niche.

I am aware that large business safes provided with doors hinged to the front side thereof are in common use; therefore the novelty

and distinctive character of my design is the application of the door to a toy safe, in combination with the niche and figure of a watchman, as shown in the drawing forming part of this application.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design of a "toy safe" in which the front is composed of a door, niche, and figure of a watchman, substantially as shown and described.
